Ever wonder how those teams get to the Little League World Series on ESPN in late August? For many of those parents of All-Stars who aren't quite sure where your next game will be. We have listed all the various 2017 tournament levels for each division.

### Little League (10-12) All-Star Tournament Information

#### District Level

We host a double elimination tournament with the 11 Little League teams that are in our District. The District tournament runs June 24<sup>th</sup> - July 7<sup>th</sup>. The winner of the District 33 tournament advances to Sectional level.

#### Section Level

We are in Section 6, which includes the following Districts: District 31, District 32, District 33 and District 70. The games will be played July 8<sup>th</sup> - July 16<sup>th</sup>. District 32 is hosting the games. The winner of this tournament will advance to the State level.

#### Southern California State

Southern California State is made up of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10. Southern California this year will have one tournament with all 10 sections participating to determine the state winner. This tournament will be hosted by District 38 in Long Beach from July 19<sup>th</sup> – July 30<sup>th</sup>. The winner of this tournament will advance to the Western Regional level.

#### Western Region

The California State Champions (North and South) and the 4 other State Champions will play August 6<sup>th</sup> - August 12<sup>th</sup> in San Bernardino, California. The winner will advance to the Little League World Series.

#### Little League World Series

8 US Regional winners and 8 International winners play August 17<sup>th</sup> - August 27<sup>th</sup> in the Little League World Series in Williamsport, Pennsylvania.

### Section Level

### Southern California State

All Sectional winners play in a State Tournament from July 19<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>. District 23 will be hosting this tournament.

Senior World Series
